IOC

It was with great sadness that the IOC learned of the death of **Judge Kéba Mbaye** at the age of 82 on 11 January. An IOC member in Senegal from 1973 to 2002, Kéba Mbaye was also an IOC Vice-President (1988-1992, 1998-2002) and an Executive Board member (1984-1988, 1993-1998). He chaired several commissions including: Apartheid and Olympism (1989-1992), Sport and Law (1995-2002), Juridical (1993-2002) and Nominations (2000-2002). The IOC announced on 10 January 2007 that it had received the Candidature Files of the three Candidate Cities for the **XXII Olympic Winter Games in 2014**. Sochi (Russian Federation), Salzburg (Austria) and PyeongChang (Republic of Korea) all submitted their files before the deadline. The host city will be selected on 4 July this year during the 119th IOC Session in Guatemala City.

The **IOC Executive Board** will meet in Lausanne on 7-8 February. The meetings will start with a joint meeting with the IOC Athletes' Commission. The EB will hear the reports from the IOC commissions and directors, as well as updates on the organisation of the forthcoming Games in Beijing, Vancouver and London.

* Beijing 2008

On 16 and 17 January, an IOC delegation, led by the Chairman of the **Coordination Commission**, Hein Verbruggen, was in the Chinese capital for the first project review of 2007. The group, composed of members of the IOC administration and experts in areas related to Games organisation, received updates on the progress of work since the last full Coordination Commission visit in October 2006 in areas such as sports, spectator services, NOC

services, the Olympic Village, media operations, venue construction and infrastructure, culture and education, and legacy. The next visit by the full Commission will be in April this year.

BOCOG launched the English **electronic Olympic map** for the official BOCOG web site. This is the first time that an official Olympic Games web site has offered such a multilingual electronic map. The map shows the Olympic venues, Olympic licensed stores, metro stations and the biggest Hutongs (traditional housing areas in Beijing), in addition to government institutions, hospitals, schools, recreational areas, tourist destinations, real estate services, catering and hotel facilities, bookshops, shopping centres, department stores and roads. * London 2012

The Games of the XXX Olympiad – London 2012 celebrated a special milestone on 23 January 2007 representing 2,012 days until the start of the London 2012 Games. As part of the celebrations, the Olympic Delivery Authority (ODA), the public body responsible for ensuring delivery of the new venues and infrastructure for the Games and the legacy that will follow, launched its Sustainable Development Strategy.



International Sport

The 4th edition of the **Australian Youth Olympic Festival**, organised at the initiative of the AOC took place in Sydney 17-21 January. Almost 2,200 young athletes aged from 13 to 19 from 20 countries took part in competitions in 16 sports.

* WADA

The first Draft Revision of the World Anti-Doping Code has been posted online. This document is the result of direct feedback from and face-to-face meetings with stakeholders as part of the first of three consultation phases and is available in English. The Code review and consultation process will culminate at the Third World Conference on Doping in Sport taking place in Madrid, Spain, 15-17 November 2007. UIPM delegation visits Berlin

From 18-19 January, meetings took place in Berlin in preparation for the 2007 World Championships, taking place in the Olympic Park, 14-22 August. UIPM President Klaus Schormann, who is also President of the host federation, led the meeting which was attended by Secretary General Joël Bouzou, Vice President for Business Affairs John Helmick and Treasurer Gyula Bretz. From the Local Organising Committee were Christian Frieden, President of MP Berlin, Heike and Bernhard Petruschinski, and attending the meetings also were Peter Hanisch, President of the Berlin Sport Association, Dr Eberhard Körting, Senator of the Interior and Sport and Gerhard Böhn, Director National and International Sport of the German Federal Chancellor's Office.

The UIPM President and Secretary General were also guests at the Opening Ceremony of the World Handball Championships in Berlin on 19 January.

UIPM President's Activities in Germany

On 9th January, President Klaus Schormann met in Frankfurt with Roland Blum a TV Production Director to discuss future projects to promote Modern Pentathlon through short images (video or internet). Following the first Games of the Handball Championships on 19 January, President Klaus Schormann met with DOSB President and IOC Vice President Thomas Bach, IHF President Hassan Moustafa together with Hassan Sakr, Chairman of the National Sports Council of Egypt, FINA President and IOC member Mustapha Larfaoui and Dr Christa Thiel, President of the German Swim Federation and Speaker of the German Sportfederation to discuss international sport relations.

At the New Year celebrations of the German Olympic Sport Federation (DOSB) in Frankfurt on 24

January, President Klaus Schormann met with Ulrich Feldhoff, President of the International Canoe Federation and Josef Fendt, President of the International Luge Federation where they exchanged opinions about financial support for developing countries. The reception had been given by DOSB President Dr Thomas Bach and Mayor of Frankfurt Dr Petra Roth in the Frankfurter Römer.

On 27 January, President Klaus Schormann met in Frankfurt with Stefan Lauer, Executive Board member of Deutsche Lufthansa where they discussed the excellent relations for many years between Lufthansa and UIPM.

On 29 January, President Klaus Schormann took part as honoured guest at the DOSB award ceremony 'Sterne des Sports' in Berlin; creative and innovative clubs received the Golden Star and prize money from German Head of State Dr Horst Köhler, DOSB President Dr Thomas Bach and Dr Christopher Pleister, President of the Deutscher Volksbanken and Raiffeisenbanken.

On the same day, the UIPM President visited the State Secretary of Berlin Senate of Interior and Sport Thomas Härtel together with Bernhard Petruschinski to discuss further steps in the preparation for the 2007 World Championships.

President Klaus Schormann met in Berlin with President of the German Olympic Society Hans-Jurgen Bartsch and Vice President Ulrike Ufert-Hoffmann to speak about a forum on 10 July where the UIPM President will be the main speaker on the Olympic Movement.

UIPM Secretary General in Lausanne

In his capacity as WOA Treasurer, UIPM Secretary General Joël Bouzou was in Lausanne on 22-23 January with President Pal Schmitt, VP Elizabeth Ferris and Board Member Charmaine Crooks to discuss future collaboration between the IOC and WOA. The delegation met with IOC President Jacques Rogge, IOC General Director Urs Lacotte IOC Sport Director Kelly Fairweather, and Director of Legal Affairs Howard Stupp.

He took also the opportunity to brief the IOC Sport Director about UIPM's plans for the forthcoming year. Discussions also took place on overall preparations for the Beijing Olympic Games as well as sport specific regarding Modern Pentathlon.

He had a final personal meeting with IOC President Jacques Rogge and IOC Director of International Cooperation and Development T.A. Ganda Sithole.

Finally he had a short meeting with ORIS Coordinator, Mr Namik Djumisik.

UIPM mourns Rudolf-August Oetker

UIPM Pierre de Coubertin medal holder Rudolf-August Oetker passed away in Hamburg on 16 January at the age of 90. He had been awarded the medal in 2005 by UIPM in recognition of his long-

term support of Modern Pentathlon, from 1969-2006. UIPM sends condolences to his family and friends.
