### UIPM Family mourns Olympian Samuel Felix

#### IOC

The IOC Executive Board met 21-22 June in Lausanne. On 21 June, the EB held joint meetings with the IOC's Athletes' Commission and with the newly formed 2009 Congress Commission during the morning session. The afternoon saw the EB hear from the Chairman of the IOC's Coordination Commission for the Torino 2006 Games, the IOC's Director General, the Olympic Games, NOC Relations, Sports and Medical departments of the IOC, and from Olympic Solidarity.

The following day, the IOC EB decided the selection of the candidate cities for the 2014 Olympic Winter Games - Sochi (Russia), Salzburg (Austria) and PyeongChang (Korea). The decision on the host city for these Games will be taken in July 2007 at the 119th IOC Session in Guatemala City.

The EB also heard reports from the Organising Committees of Beijing 2008 (BOCOG), Vancouver 2010 (VANOC) and London 2012 (LOCOG). The OCOGs were able to make their presentations by video conference to the EB, who were able to speak directly to the leaders in their offices in Beijing, Vancouver and London. The EB also heard reports from different IOC departments, such as Marketing, Technology, Legal Affairs, International Cooperation and Development, the Olympic Museum, Finance & Administration, and Communications and the TV Rights and New Media Commission.

The IOC EB decided to approve the Ethics Commission's recommendations relating to the case of Mr Guy Drut:

1. that Mr Guy Drut, IOC member, has disregarded the ethical principles set out in the Olympic Charter and the IOC Code of Ethics, has tarnished the reputation of the Olympic Movement and was thereby in breach of the Olympic Charter and the IOC Code of Ethics;

2. pursuant to Rule 23.1.1 of the Olympic Charter, to impose the following combination of sanctions on Mr Guy Drut:

- a) a reprimand; and
- b) a suspension of the right to chair any IOC commission for five years.

The following IOC Commissions meetings took place last week: Marketing (Chaired by Gerhard Heiberg), Finance (Richard Carrión), Juridical (Thomas Bach), Athletes' (Sergey Bubka) and Audit (Richard Carrión). President Rogge chaired the TV Rights and New Media Commission, as well as the first joint meeting of the Executive Board with the new 2009 Congress Commission.

Following a meeting between the IOC Executive Board and the **International Paralympic Committee (IPC)** Executive Committee, the two respective Presidents of these organisations, Jacques Rogge and Philip Craven, signed an extension to the agreement linking them, to include the Olympic and Paralympic Games in 2014 and 2016.



The Executive Committee of the **Association of National Olympic Committees of Africa (ANOCA)** has held its 30th Ordinary Session in Algiers (Algeria). A **Convention on the Afro-Asian Games**, which will take place in Algiers in 2007, was signed by Algerian Minister of Youth and Sports Yahia Guidoum, and ANOCA President Lassana Palenfo.

**\* IOC Culture and Olympic Education Commission**

Robert Parienté, a member of the Commission for Culture and Olympic Education, died on 28 May in Paris (France), at the age of 75. He was Editor in Chief of the French daily newspaper "L'Équipe" (1976-1980), Editorial Director (1980- 1986) then Deputy Director General (1986-1993). In 1998, Robert Parienté was appointed to the IOC's Cultural Commission, then the Commission for Culture and Olympic Education. He was also the author of many works of reference such as "The Fabulous Story of the Olympic Games" and "The Fabulous Story of Athletics".



**\* 2008 Beijing**

BOCOG)recently announced that 110 one- to five-star hotels will be built to meet the demand for accommodation during the Games. In 2007, the number of star-rated hotels should reach 800, or almost 130,000 rooms. These hotels should accommodate almost 550,000 people a day during the Games.

**\* 2010 Vancouver**

The Coordination Commission for the XXI Olympic Winter Games in 2010, was in Vancouver to examine the progress made by the Organising Committee (VANOC) since April 2005. Different points were addressed during the plenary meetings, notably the level of services to be provided to NOCs, IFs, sponsors, media and the International Paralympic Committee; venue planning and construction; and sustainable development. The Commission also visited Whistler to take a firsthand look at progress made in competition venue construction.

**\* 2012 London**

On 7 June, a **delegation from UIPM comprising President Klaus Schormann, Secretary General Joël Bouzou and EB Member Martin Dawe**, met with Sports Director Debbie Jevans and Senior Sports Coordinator David Luckes at the LOCOG offices in Canary Wharf. The main point on the

agenda was UIPM's wish to hold all the disciplines of the sport within Olympic Park to allow for improved transportation between events for athletes and spectators. LOCOG has agreed to look at the implications of the move of all disciplines into Olympic Park.



**UIPM**

President **Klaus Schormann** and Secretary General **Joël Bouzou** attended the opening ceremony of the 18th FIFA World Cup and the inaugural match, Germany versus Costa Rica, in Munich on 9 June.

President **Klaus Schormann** visited Sports Authorities in Sofia, Bulgaria and Bucharest, Romania from 15-19 June.

During the visit of the UIPM President in **Bulgaria** from 15-17 June, the following main issues were discussed with the different authorities in Sofia:

- development of Modern Pentathlon through the basic disciplines of run and swim in close co-operation with schools and sport clubs – School Biathle is one of the best keys to start
- the establishment of Balkan Games for all age categories in Modern Pentathlon, the first of which will be held in Athens, 8-11 September for Youth A and B athletes
- development of MP in co-operation with universities, police and military using the infrastructure of sport facilities and knowledge of trainers, etc

Partners in these meetings were Mr Svetoslav Spassov (member of Parliament) Chairman of the Children, Youth and Sports Affairs Committee of the XL national Assembly of the Republic of Bulgaria; Mrs Stefka Kostadinova, President of the Bulgarian Olympic Committee; Pr Lazar Kamenov PhD Vice rector at the National Sports Academy 'Vasil Levski' and former pentathlete and chief coach of MP in Bulgaria; Mrs Vessela Letcheva, President of the State Agency for Youth & Sport in the Republic of Bulgaria and Olympic Medallist in Shooting.

President Klaus Schormann met in the Chamber of Commerce Germany-Bulgaria with the principal manager Dr. oec. Mitko Vassilev on 16 June to discuss the issue of sport and tourism and the possibilities of companies to use sport as a way to contact their consumers. Sport is becoming increasingly seen as a partner for politicians and specifically for the business society. Olympic sport is on side and the sport for all (like Biathle) is



another side and building together a strong partnership.

The UIPM President made visits on 16 and 17 June to the City Veliko Turnovo, which is the capital of the second Bulgarian region, together with UIPM Technical Committee secretary Pr Ivan Popov to evaluate the possibilities for future youth competitions in this wonderful historical environment. The Vice Mayor Yordan Grozdanov showed them the facilities at the University and also the equestrian centre in a small village near the city. The Pentathlon Club will bid for European and Youth Championships in the near future.

President Klaus Schormann visited Bucharest, **Romania** from 17-19 June together with Pr Ivan Popov to meet with the Romanian Swimming & Modern Pentathlon Federation President Viorel Jon Paunesco and Secretary General Stefan Iamandi and chief coach Dumitru Sparla (former world class athlete). They discussed mainly the future steps for the Balkan Games in Modern Pentathlon and the possibilities to develop MP through Biathle. Their special situation as federation also for swimming gives a wonderful help in close co-operational projects.

Similar situation to Bulgaria, there are not enough pools in Romania of a sport standard. The wish from all discussions is that the governments are more open for stronger financial support for physical education.

On 19 June, the UIPM President discussed with the NOC Secretary General Mr Ioan Dobrescu the situation of Modern Pentathlon in the Olympic Movement and briefed him about the new changes in the near future such as combined shoot and run and the laser pistol development. The Romanian NOC will strongly support Youth Balkan Games also on the financial base and will assist to build up again strong Modern Pentathlon athletes.

On 21 June, UIPM President Klaus Schormann met during the FIFA World Cup match Argentina v Netherlands in Frankfurt with IOC member and President of the International Hockey Federation Mrs Els van Breda Vriesman and IOC member and President of the Internationals Tennis Federation Mr Francesco Ricci Bitti, when they discussed future needed activities in ASOIF in preparation of the 2008 and 2012 Olympic Games, and afterwards.

The UIPM President visited the International German Championships Women, Junior Women and Junior Men in Bonn, 23-25 June, where he met

with Kim Raisner, member of the UIPM Athletes' Committee to speak about MP development for Women worldwide such as more activities being set up by National Federations, especially in Africa and the Middle East.

EB Member **Pernille Svarre** has been appointed member of an international business committee in Denmark, chaired by IOC member Kai Holm, with a view to building international relations in the lead up to the 2009 IOC Congress in Copenhagen. Together with 7 other Danish members of international sport unions, the first meeting is on 15<sup>th</sup> August.

Medical Committee Chairman Pr **Fabio Pigozzi** was elected Secretary General of the International Federation of Sport Medicine until 2010 at the FIMS Congress held in Beijing on 15th June 2006. UIPM sent congratulations on behalf of the Modern Pentathlon family on the election result. #### **World Cup #4 Women, Szekesfehervar, 2-4 June**

In the presence of UIPM President Klaus Schormann and UIPM Treasurer Gyula Bretz, the Modern Pentathlon Women's World Cup #4 was held in the historic 10th century city of Szekesfehervar, Hungary. During the World Cup, President **Klaus Schormann** discussed with the Mayor Kedves Olvasó and the Deputy Mayor András Szelier possibilities for future international competitions in Szekesfehervar based on the ever increasing privatisation of national and city companies. With HMPA President Attila Csázári, the President spoke about the European Championships in July 2006 and preparations for the Senior World Championships in 2008 in Budapest.

On 3 June, President Klaus Schormann was guest of honour at the award ceremony of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Alba Regia International Film Festival in Szekesfehervar, invited by festival director Blanka Elekes Szentágotai in his capacity as member of the IOC Commission for Culture and Olympic Education.

The **World Cup competition** ran June 2-4 and included a team relay event. On the Final day, Canada's Monica Pinette won the Shoot with 1206 MP points from 189 target points; Lena Shoneborn (GER) and Tatsiana Mazurkevich (BLR) tied in the Fence with 944 MP points (20 victories against 11



defeats) but after 2 events, Zhou Liu (CHN) was in the lead and World Champions Claudia Corsini (ITA) in 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

US athlete Shelia Taormina won the swim event with a time of 2:08.5 for 1380 points and Claudia Corsini took the lead after 3 events, 2004 Olympic Champion Zsuzsanna Vörös (HUN) moving up to tie with Zhou Liu for 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

8 athletes achieved the perfect 1200 MP score in the ride with a further 8 completing the course with only one fault. Zhou Liu being one of those who only made one mistake, took the lead after 4 events and started the Run 7 seconds ahead of Zsuzsanna Vörös and 10 seconds ahead of Claudia Corsini. However she was unable to maintain this lead and dropped well down the field over the 3000m course. Moving in the opposite direction were this year's CISM World Champion Viktoria Tereschuk (UKR) who started out in 9<sup>th</sup> place and Olympic Bronze Medallist Georgina Harland (GBR) with start number 22. **Viktoria Tereschuk's** 40 second handicap was no handicap at all as she overtook every athlete in front of her to cross the finish line in 1<sup>st</sup> place and **Georgina Harland** moved up to 3<sup>rd</sup> place with the fastest run of 10 minutes and 23 seconds, just behind Olympic Gold medallist **Zsuzsanna Vörös**. Sheila Taormina was second fastest in the run with a time of 10:26 and moved from 25<sup>th</sup> place up to 5<sup>th</sup> place overall.

### **Biathlon World Tour 2006**

The Biathlon World Tour #2 event was held in Follonica Italy on 4 June.

"The competition took place on a sunny day, 27° temperature, water temperature 21°. The Run was on the boulevard della Vittoria and the Swim in the sea, which was particularly calm. Around 600-700 spectators were present as well as another 300 at the sea side. Despite an entry list of 280, only two-thirds competed due mainly to national transport problems which led to 9 Italian teams unable to reach the competition site in time. Nevertheless, from 10 competing nations, 119 athletes registered results, 43 did not finish and 5 were disqualified. The competition was valid also for National Championships." *Alessandro Pratesi, Event Director*
